



Adelante High School Student Athlete Contract:

_____ has a desire to compete for Adelante in a special athletics course and be a Warrior Student Athlete. Since participation in this athletic course is a privilege, not a right, the decision to participate in this course comes with certain student responsibilities.

The general philosophy of Adelante's special athletic courses is for academic and social development growth of all students who participate in one of the four special athletic courses offered through the school year. With this growth mindset goal in mind, through participation in the special athletic courses Adelante student-athletes should demonstrate Warrior PRIDE in the following ways:

1. **P- Prepared-** Warrior student athletes will come to school and practice prepared with materials needed and ready to work and learn. Student athletes will bring all equipment and items needed for competition.
2. **R- Respect-** Warrior student athletes will respect all teachers, school staff, and students along with all coaches, teammates, opposing players, game officials, and game venue/facilities at all times.
3. **I- Involved-** Warrior student athletes will come to school and practice daily, they will wear dress clothing on game days, they will cheer on their teammates at all times.
4. **D- Disciplined-** Warrior student athletes will remain respectful and calm even when emotions are running high during competition and on school grounds. Student athletes will push themselves out of their comfort zones to get better both on the field and in the classroom.
5. **E- Efficient-** When Warrior student athletes are in class they are completing their work on time. When a student athlete is forced to miss class due to competition, they will complete their missing assignments in a timely manner.

Eligibility Requirements for Continued Enrollment and Game Competition:

**** Eligibility for continued enrollment and game participation shall be determined by Adelante teachers, administration and head coach.****

1. All student athletes must have a current physical and permission slip on file for that athletic season. All physicals are valid for the entire school year. The permission slip is valid for that athletic quarter.
2. All student athletes shall meet the academic requirement of no Fs. All academic progress will be reviewed the evening before a game to determine eligibility. When a student has an F in a current class, they cannot practice or compete until the grade is back to a passing mark.
3. All student athletes must have a minimum of 4 days of full attendance for the week unless prior communication and approval from administration or coach. All student athletes must attend practice on Thursdays. If the student athlete misses more than one full day of school and or a Thursday practice the student athlete will not be able to compete.
4. Student athletes must not have any suspensions. If a student athlete has a disciplinary action that results in a suspension during the week, the student is not allowed to compete in the following game.
5. Student athletes must have no outstanding detentions to be eligible to compete.

****If at any time, any of the eligibility requirements are not being met, Adelante has the right to remove your student from the class.****
