In order to be considered a candidate for the State Seal of Bi-literacy I have met or I am on track to meet the following requirements:

**Four years of English-Language Arts** with an overall grade point average of 2.0 or higher. (*Attach a copy of transcript*)

**Proficiency in one or more languages**, other than English, demonstrated through **one** of the following (*Attach a copy of scores*):

- o Successful completion of a **four-year high school course of study in a foreign (world) language**, attaining an overall grade point average of 3.0 or higher in that course of study, **and** demonstration of **oral proficiency** in the language comparable to that required to pass an AP or IB examination.
- o Passing an Advanced Placement exam in any foreign language with a score of 3 or higher
- o Passing an International Baccalaureate exam in any foreign language with a score of 4 or higher
- o Passing the SAT II Subject Test in Foreign Language with a score of 600 or higher

If the primary language of a student is other than English, he or she shall demonstrate English proficiency on the English Language Proficiency Assessments for California (ELPAC) by receiving an overall score of 4 (***only applicable if student is English Learner***)

\*Students will receive email notification regarding their eligibility.

\*Potentially qualified students who plan to use late Spring SAT Subject Tests or AP/IB Exam results may not receive their recognition or insignia on diploma until after graduation

\*Please note: If a student wishes to demonstrate proficiency in a language that is not available in any of the above mentioned criteria (e.g., AP/IB Exam, Four-Year Course of Study, or SAT Subject Test) then the district may work with an outside agency to obtain an appropriate assessment that meets the same standard as the other assessments/criteria. The district may need to certify the rigor of the alternate assessment to the State Superintendent of Public Instruction (SSPI)
