Dress Code

- Clothing shall be clean, neat and free from obscene writing or images. Drug, alcohol, weapons or tobacco inferences, text and/or logos are prohibited (example: Connetics, Cookies, etc.)
- Shoes are to be worn on the school grounds at all times.
- Clothing shall be within the bounds of decency and good taste. Extremes in clothing deemed as inappropriate for school and/or cause a distraction from the learning process are not permitted.
- Examples of inappropriate attire include (but not limited to):
 - Extremely short shorts or skirts. The buttocks must be covered at all times, including when seated.
 - Shirts and/or tops that expose bare midriffs
 - Strapless, open back, halter or tube tops
 - Low-cut or revealing tops including low-cut tank tops and muscle shirts.
 - Clothing that exposes undergarments (including bandeau's)
 - Apparel, including bandanas, that may indicate gang affiliation or violate the District gang profile.
 - Metal studded accessories such as necklaces, wrist bands, rings or heavy chains.

Teachers and coaches may impose more stringent requirements than the above, as appropriate.

Students in violation of the dress code shall be sent to the office until the violation is corrected. Continual violation of the dress code may result in disciplinary action.
