- Canvas Information, Matt Long (WHS Teacher)
 - Our new district learning management system is called Canvas. It will be a 3 year transition.
 - Community colleges use Canvas, as well as the top schools our students are attending.
 - O About ⅓ of our teachers are using it already. There's a learning curve for both students and teachers..

- Student benefits: Unified app for all classwork, there is a calendar that is organized by due dates/assessments, improved messaging and communication
- Parent benefits: Observer accounts that allow parents to view assignments/submissions, view calendar and gradebooks, communication with teachers
- Chromebooks will allow all students to use Canvas.
- The gradebook is in Aeries/Homelink and Canvas (linked).
- Getting set up in Canvas is a bit time-consuming, but staff are learning and will adapt.
- Students POV: Everything is really accessible and it makes it easier to keep up if you
 miss class. It is similar to Google classroom. At Sierra, the professors use it really
 uniquely (in a positive way) and it seems like our teachers are starting to use it similarly
 which is great. Some teachers started the school year with Canvas, but have switched
 back to Google Classroom out of ease.
