- Information regarding sexual assault, intimate partner violence and human trafficking

Confidential Emergency Safe House

- 90-day stay
- 55-bed facility
- Available to survivors and their non-offending family members
- 1x1 case management

- All services are offered on-site
- Communal kitchens, living room, food pantry and laundry facility
- Minors must be accompanied by a parent or guardian

Human Trafficking Drop-In Center

- Open regular office hours
- Safe space to hang out, relax, and access services
- 1x1 case management
- Job retraining, resume building, workshops and skill building

- Food, clothing and hygiene pantries
- Books, games, movies, internet access, video games, rest
- Therapeutic services
- Confidential HIV testing and access to birth control

24/7 Accompaniment Services

- Hospital accompaniment to sexual assault forensic exams
- Accompaniment services to police, station, court, jails, juvenile detention facilities, group homes, social services, medical clinics, and other locations as requested
- On-scene response with law enforcement to support and advocate for survivors
- Emotional support, crisis intervention, medical and legal advocacy, connect survivors with programs/services

Therapy Services

- Individual therapy for adults and children ages 3+
- Available at Auburn and Roseville service offices
- Also offered to significant others, family members, friends and witnesses to violence
- Recent or past trauma

Group Therapy & Support Groups

- Sexual Assault Art Therapy:
 - Adult group- Held once a week for eight consecutive weeks
 - o Teen group- ongoing
 - Intake with a therapist is required

- Support Groups:
 - o Domestic Violence
 - Human Trafficking
 - Sexual Assault
 - o Teens
 - Parents/Guardians

Legal Services

- Available to all survivors:
 - Assistance filling out and filing Temporary Restraining Orders
 - Court accompaniment
 - Assistance with child custody and divorce
 - Technical guidance of the court system
 - o Legal clinic

- Available to survivors of sex trafficking:
 - Financial and legal assistance with T and U visas
 - Assistance with eviction removal, poor credit
 - o Legal representation in court
 - Financial assistance for other court fees

Rapid Re-Housing Program

- Rental assistance for up to two years
- Bi-weekly support group
- Housing orientation and interview required before admittance
- Weekly case management, financial coaching, community resources, time management skills and the creation of an individualized success plan

Other Emergency & Supportive Services

- Hotel vouchers
- Transportation vouchers- bus and taxi, Uber rides
- Assistance signing up for Medi-Cal, CalFresh, WIC and CalWORKS
- Job readiness
- Food and clothing assistance
- Financial coaching
