

Close Contact to Positive COVID-19 Case (Vaccinated)

*** School will communicate last date of exposure to all close contacts

Vaccinated Individuals – Close Contact

1. If **Asymptomatic**:
 - a. No Quarantine needed with vaccination verification.
 - i. Simply monitor symptoms for 14 days after exposure (Please refer to CDPH fully vaccinated people guidance for more information).
2. If **Symptomatic** (If any symptoms develop during 14-day period):
 - a. Isolate (At home)
 - i. Get tested (PRC or Antigen)
 - ii. Contact health care provider with any questions regarding care
 - iii. Please sign into Screener 19 during Isolation.

FOR ALL CLOSE CONTACTS

If quarantine discontinues before 14 days following last known exposure, asymptomatic close contacts **MUST**:

1. Continue daily self-monitoring for symptoms through day 14 from last known exposure; **AND**
2. Follow all recommended non-pharmaceutical interventions (e.g., wearing a mask when around others, hand washing, avoiding crowds) through day 14 from last known exposure.

Close Contact to Positive COVID-19 Case (**Unvaccinated**)

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Unvaccinated Individuals – Close Contacts

1. Case **&** Close Contact **BOTH WEARING A MASK**:
 - a. **Asymptomatic** (Modified Quarantine Option - stay in school **IF**):
 - i. Remain asymptomatic
 - ii. Continue to mask as required
 - iii. Undergo at least twice weekly testing during quarantine
 - b. **Symptomatic** (If symptoms develop within 14 days of exposure):
 - i. Isolate (Stay at home)
 - ii. Get tested (PCR or Antigen)
 - iii. Contact health care provider with questions regarding care
 - iv. Please sign into Screener 19 during quarantine.

2. Case **&/or** Close Contact **NOT WEARING A MASK**:
 - a. **Asymptomatic**
 - i. Quarantine from all activities, including in-person learning and community activities (Must Stay Home)
 1. Quarantine may end **EITHER**:
 - a. After 10 days from last date of exposure without testing **OR**
 - b. After day 7 if a diagnostic specimen is collected after day 5 from the date of last exposure and tests negative
 - b. **Symptomatic** (If symptoms develop within 14 days of exposure):
 - i. Isolate (Stay at home)
 - ii. Get tested (PCR or Antigen)
 - iii. Contact health care provider with questions regarding care
 - iv. Please sign into Screener 19 during quarantine

FOR ALL CLOSE CONTACTS

If quarantine discontinues before 14 days following last known exposure, asymptomatic close contacts **MUST**:

3. Continue daily self-monitoring for symptoms through day 14 from last known exposure; **AND**

4. Follow all recommended non-pharmaceutical interventions (e.g., wearing a mask when around others, hand washing, avoiding crowds) through day 14 from last known exposure.
