

## Antelope High School CAASPP Letter #2

### Spring 2022

March 28, 2022

Dear Parents/Guardians:

This year all Juniors, along with 60 Seniors, will participate in the California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress. Juniors will take the Smarter Balanced Summative Assessments for English Language Arts, Mathematics, and the California Science Test (CAST). Seniors who have not yet completed their CAST assessments will test on the last day of testing. All students will meet in assigned classrooms by alpha according to their last names. Emails will be sent to the Seniors who have yet to complete their testing. All CAASPP assessments will be completed in person at Antelope High School on the following days: Wednesday, April 20th (ELA), Thursday, April 21st (Math), and Tuesday, April 26th (Science).

We expect all 11th grade students to be in their assigned classroom by 7:45 am each day and remain & until testing is complete. These timings and schedules are seen below:

- April 20th, (ELA CAT & PT) and April 21st, Math (CAT & PT) - 7:45 am - 11:10 am (11th Graders Only)
- April 26th, Science (CAST) - 7:45am - 10 am (11th Graders and sixty 12th Graders)

All other grade levels (9, 10, 12th) that are not testing, will report to school at the following timings:

- April 20th and April 21st: All report at 11:10 am
- April 26th: All 9th, 10th, and the 60 Seniors taking CAST will report at 10:00 am

All students will resume scheduled classes as written with adjusted timings. **There will only be one lunch period on testing days.** On all three days of testing, students will be released at 2:35pm. Please note that Wednesday, April 20th, will not be a minimum day. Please view the schedule below. These schedules are also posted on our school website along with room assignments for students.
