Purchasing a Ticket

- Tickets will only be sold to students possessing a current student ID card and their approved guests with a bid (only available for Prom and Senior Ball).
- Students with fines will not be allowed to purchase a ticket.
- Tickets will only be sold to students and guests who have signed contracts on file.
- Ticket prices will vary throughout the ticket-sales period, and exceptions will not be granted to students who do not have fine or bids cleared in time to receive discounted prices.
- Tickets are ONLY sold DURING LUNCH at the outdoor finance window area.
- TICKETS ARE NEVER SOLD AFTER SCHOOL OR AT THE DOOR.

The Guest Bid

- Bids are only available for Prom and Senior Ball.
 - Students with fines are unable to purchase a Guest Bid.
 - Guest bids cost \$5. This does not cover the cost of the dance ticket which is a separate cost.
 - No bid will be approved for guests over the age of 20.
- No non-Woodcreek student will be admitted to the dance without the approved Bid Card (provided to the Woodcreek student once the Bid is approved) and a current ID.
- The Bid paperwork requires signatures from parents of the Woodcreek student and parents of the guest along with approvals from the administration at both the guest's school and Woodcreek High School, so be sure to start the process of bid approval early!

Students who purchase Guest Bids are required to inform their guests of all contract rules.

- Guests are required to abide by all school rules.
- Any student or guest exhibiting disruptive behavior will be removed from the dance and the student or guest will be released to the current student parent or police if parent(s) cannot be reached.
- The current Woodcreek student will be held accountable for the behavior of their guest.
- No reimbursement or refund will be given when asked to leave the dance for not following this agreement.

Admittance

- Admittance/attendance is subject to Administration approval.
- All students must present an ID card at the door for admission.
 - Current students must present a valid Student ID Card.
 - Guests of current students must present a picture ID.
 - **Students or guests without the appropriate ID will NOT be admitted!**
- Students will not be allowed in the parking lot area or any area outside of the designated secure area unless they are leaving the event.
- Once students leave the secured dance area they are no longer supervised, and they will not be readmitted to the dance.
- Supervision for dances ends 15 minutes after the end of the dance.
- Only envelope-sized purses allowed into the dance.
 - These must be checked at coat check and are subject to search.
 - **Students are not allowed to change clothing at any dance.**
- Gates will close one hour after the dance begins.

Once Inside of the Dance

- Students can store personal items (at their own risk) in the coat check for Homecoming, Aurora Borealis, Prom and Senior Ball.
 - All items are subject to search by an administrator.
 - All students must wear shoes all night.
 - If high heels are turned in to coat check, the students must have another pair of shoes to wear for dancing.
- Snacks are often available for purchase.
 - In addition, water is always provided free of charge.

Once Inside of the Dance

- All school rules outlined in the school handbook will be strictly enforced.
- Students under the influence of alcohol or drugs will not be admitted and will be subject to school and criminal penalty.
 - If students are found to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs at any time during a dance, parents will be contacted and will be expected to come and pick their student up at the dance immediately.
 - Students found to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs will be suspended from school and may be cited by the police.
 - Any student found to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs will be excluded from the next two dances and may be excluded from senior events including the graduation ceremony.

Once Inside of the Dance

- Dress Code will be enforced.

 - No clothing may be removed that would cause a student's outfit to fail the dress code.
 - A student failing the dress code at any time throughout the dance will be removed from the dance. No refund will be given.

Once Inside of the Dance

- ALL students deserve the opportunity to dance in an environment that is safe, respectful and appropriate.
 - No “dirty dancing” of any kind will be allowed.
 - Appropriate use of CONSENT is required.
 - No student should dance with or touch another student without that student’s clear verbal permission.

- Students participating in inappropriate dancing behaviors will be removed from the dance (no refund given), will be excluded from the next two dances, and may face advanced disciplinary action on a case-by-case basis.

Once Inside of the Dance

- Dancing must be safe.
 - Moshing or slam dancing is prohibited.
 - The dance floor becomes unsafe when students do not allow “breathing room”.
 - Students crowding together create an illusion that the dance floor is too small. In truth, THERE IS ALWAYS PLENTY OF ROOM FOR ALL STUDENTS TO SPREAD OUT AND HAVE SPACE TO DANCE SAFELY.
 - If your student feels that they are in an area that is too crowded, they should move away from the crowds --this usually means moving away from “the middle”.
 - Crowd surfing is not allowed and will result in immediate removal from the dance (without a refund), exclusion from the next two dances and possible suspension.
 - Unsafe behaviors of any kind may result in removal from the dance (no refund given), exclusion from the next two dances and possible suspension.
 - If the administrator in charge feels that the dance floor has become unsafe for ANY reason, the lights may come on, the music may stop, and the dance may even be stopped for the remainder of the night (without a refund).

The safety of our students is our #1 priority!
