

ROBOT/ALIEN (100 points)
GROUPS OF 2 to 3 people – IN SPANISH 2

TASK: You and your partner have been hired by an engineering company to design a *new robot/alien*. You may present it in either *3D, computer generated, poster board* or *8 x 11 paper* through elmo. You are going to share your original *robot/alien* with your classmates and it should be “impressive.” You are expected to use as much vocabulary as possible that was covered this year. You are also expected to use a variety of verb tenses when appropriate: *present, preterite, imperfect*. (100 points) ****If presentation is read, then highest grade will be 50%. Expectation is to present, not read. This is a speaking assessment, not a reading one.**

Project Description (You may do this with a partner)

Step 1: Look through your *notes* and *units* that we have covered this year. Think about how you are going to *create* your **ROBOT/ALIEN**. Consider how you are going to combine your notes and robot/alien to make a successful presentation.

Step 2: Create *3D, computer generated, poster board* or *8 x 11 paper* to document the visuals of your robot/alien.

Step 3: Prepare to **describe** what the robot/alien **looks like/clothes wearing** and what its **likes and dislikes** are to the class **in detail** using as much different vocabulary learned this term as possible. **Name the body parts**, and describe its **daily routine** using *reflexive verbs*. Must use at least **3 different reflexive verbs per person**.

Step 4: Describe at least **one room** and **2 pieces of furniture** with **adjectives** the *robot/alien* has in his/her house. Share at least **3 activities/chores** your robot/alien did last week using the *preterite*. **HINT: La semana pasada . . .** Share at least **3 activities/chores** your robot/alien did when it was younger using the *imperfect*. **HINT: De pequeño/a . . .**

** The above is to be done *per person* and they must all be *different rooms/furniture/activities/chores*.

Step 5: Give directions on how the *robot/alien* gets from one place to another. **per person*

Step 6: Present your *robot/alien* to the class el **JUEVES, el 24 de mayo**. **Extra Credit** if presented el **MIERCOLES, el 23 de mayo**. **Make sure each person completes their share and speaks for at least 90 seconds.*

****NOTE:** If you are doing a computer generated presentation, your presentation has to be on my computer at the beginning of **WEDNESDAY (5.23)** or else you will need to print the slides and present through Elmo.

COMPREHENSIBILITY (Understand pronunciation/sentence structure) (x 5 = 20 points)

- 1 --Responses barely comprehensible
- 2 --Responses mostly comprehensible, requiring interpretation on the part of the listener
- 3 --Responses comprehensible, requiring minimal interpretation on the part of the listener
- 4 --Responses readily comprehensible, requiring no interpretation on the part of the listener

FLUENCY OF SPEAKING (NOT READING) (x 5 = 20 points)

- 1 --Speech halting and uneven with long pauses and/or incomplete thoughts
- 2 --Speech choppy and/or slow with frequent pauses, few or no incomplete thoughts
- 3 --Some hesitation but manages to continue and complete thoughts
- 4 --Speech continuous with few pauses or stumbling

QUALITY OF INTERACTION (Real conversation interaction) (x 5 = 20 points)

- 1 --Minimal engagement in the interaction; little ability to sustain the conversation.
- 2 --Some engagement in the interaction; some ability to sustain the conversation.
- 3 --Consistent engagement in the interaction; ability to sustain the conversation.
- 4 --Consistent engagement in the interaction; ability to sustain and advance the conversation.

VOCABULARY (Completed the task. Good variety and balance from all 2 years) (x 5 = 20 points)

- 1 --Inadequate and/or inaccurate use of vocabulary.
- 2 -- Somewhat inadequate and/or inaccurate use of vocabulary and too basic for this level.
- 3 --Adequate and accurate use of vocabulary for this level.
- 4 --Rich use of vocabulary, with some idiomatic expressions.

GRAMMAR (PRONOUN AND VERB AGREEMENT) (x 5 = 20 points)

- 1 - Basic
- 2 - Emerging
- 3 - Advanced with some errors
- 4 - Advanced with control
