Senior Meeting--May 3:

On May 3, we held a meeting with the Senior Class to review a variety of informational items. Seniors were informed of various deadlines and items they needed to do. Below are some of the links with a brief description.

- [College Wall of Fame Pennants](#)--Seniors can complete this form with any post-secondary option they have been admitted to following graduation. A pennant will be added to our "Wall of Fame" to celebrate these admissions.
- ["College" Signing Day](#)--Monday, May 13 is a day to celebrate what seniors are doing after graduation. Seniors who complete this form by Friday, May 10 will have their name announced with what their plans are post-graduation, whether it be college, military, or trade school. This ceremony will be held in the amphitheater during lunch.
- [Senior Survey](#)--This survey must be completed by all seniors prior to graduation. If a senior chooses to report a scholarship or award that they would like announced on Senior Awards Night, they need to complete this form no later than Friday, May 10.

Senior Ball--Saturday, May 11:

Senior Ball is at the Doubletree Hotel located at 2001 Point West Way, Sacramento, CA 95815. Doors open at 6:30 PM, with dinner being served at 7:30 PM. **All students must have their current Roseville High School ID card to be admitted**, and their guest bid if bringing a non-RHS guest. All attendees must arrive by 7:15 PM. Even though this event is off-campus, all school rules are in effect.

Any student who has not signed up for a specific table needs to go to room 202 to request one. A table seating chart will be posted in Senior Square on Thursday so that students are able to make sure it is accurate.

Senior Awards Night--Monday, May 20:

Senior Awards Night will be held in Moeller Gymnasium due to the number of Seniors being recognized for their outstanding work over their four years at Roseville High School. Seniors will be presented with Academic Merit Awards, Scholarships, and other recognitions of their achievements. Senior Awards Night begins at 7:00 PM. Seniors receiving awards are asked to arrive no later than 6:45 PM.

Senior Day--Wednesday, May 22:

Seniors were given permission slips last week on Friday if they wish to attend. **Seniors attending must return the permission slip signed by a parent no later than Friday, May 10.** If your student did not get a permission slip on Friday, they can get one from Ms. Toste in the Assistant Principals' office, or [download the form here](#).

On Senior Day, students check in at the cafeteria starting at 7:45 AM. All bags will be checked. No open liquid containers will be allowed. Empty water bottles are fine, and can be filled inside the cafeteria at the filling station. Students must arrive at the cafeteria no later than 8:15 AM.

Students will be provided breakfast in the cafeteria sponsored by the Senior Class. They will then take a bus to Auburn Rec Park where they can swim, hang out, and enjoy lunch, also sponsored by the class. We will return to RHS by 2:00 PM.

All students participating in Senior Day must take the bus to and from the park.

Senior Sunset--Thursday, May 30:

Senior Sunset is mandatory for all graduating Seniors. It begins at 6:30 PM. Graduates need to officially check out by making sure they have no outstanding fines and have completed the [Senior Exit Survey](#). Then they will be able to pick up their graduation tickets and caps & gowns. (Graduates who have not yet ordered their caps & gowns should contact [Jostens](#) ASAP.)

Graduation Practice--Friday, May 31:

All graduates participating in the Graduation Ceremony MUST attend the Graduation Practice. It begins at 8:00 AM on Hanson Field and runs until 12 noon. Given typically sunny, hot mornings, we encourage graduates to bring water and wear sunscreen.

Graduation Ceremony--Friday, May 31:

The Graduation Ceremony begins at 7:00 PM. Gates will open at 5:45 PM. ***All spectators need a ticket for admission***, with the exception of children under 1 year old. The Patti Baker Theater will be open on a first come, first served basis to provide an air-conditioned venue for people to view the ceremony. No tickets are needed for the Patti Baker Theater. Family and friends can also watch the live stream of the ceremony via a link which will be posted on the [RHS webpage](#).

Graduates need to arrive in Senior Square, between the Boys' Locker Room and the Pool, by 5:45 PM. Graduates should have their caps on and their gowns over their arm when they arrive.

As the ceremony is a formal event, we ask graduates to dress semi-formally. Any heels need to be the width of a quarter or more so as not to cause damage to the artificial turf.

Graduation Tickets:

Each graduate will be given eight (8) tickets--two (2) VIP field seats and six (6) general admission tickets for the home side bleachers.

While some families won't need all eight tickets, many families will find this is not enough. Graduates are encouraged to seek out anyone who may not need all of their tickets. We also ask if your family does not need all eight, return the unneeded tickets to the school on the night of Senior Sunset so that we can make them available to those who need them.

Some years, graduates with extra tickets attempt to sell them to the highest bidder. This is unfair. If you know of anyone who is offering to sell tickets, please contact Mr. Pipitone, Assistant Principal to inform him of who is doing this. Graduates attempting to sell tickets may lose their tickets as a result.
