11th GRADE TIMELINE

MARCH-JUNE

- Create calendar of college application deadlines and financial aid application deadlines.
- SAT+writing (test in May, June, or August/ send scores when registering)
- ACT+writing (test in Apr or June/ send scores when reg.)
- Keep list of awards, honors, extracurricular activities
- Prospective college athletes must register with the NCAA Eligibility Center.
- Send SAT/ACT scores to NCAA (student athletes)
- College Campus Visits
- Contact Military Recruiters

12th GRADE TIMELINE

JULY-AUGUST

- Narrow list of colleges to 6-10 schools
- Visit colleges – call in advance for tour/open house dates and times.
- Participate in summer volunteer work and/or internships.
- Register early for Fall SAT and ACT tests.

SEPTEMBER

- Review all college admissions requirements and deadlines.
- Check with the financial aid offices of all of the colleges you are applying to and **confirm the priority filing deadlines for financial aid applications.**
- Register for the SAT, SAT Subject Tests, and ACT+writing.
- Provide recommenders with Letters of Recommendation forms (available at www.rosevilletigers.org > Counseling > Letters of Recommendation)
- Visit the FAFSA Web site (www.fafsa.ed.gov) to become familiar with content.
- Help your parents gather documents for completing FAFSA.

OCTOBER

- Complete the FAFSA!** Submit FAFSA as soon as possible beginning October 1st and before March 2nd.
- Register for December SAT and ACT tests.
- Take SAT and ACT tests.
- Submit early decision/early action applications.
- Begin working on UC and CSU applications (CSU applications can be submitted in October).
- Apply to SIERRA COLLEGE** to meet priority registration deadlines.
- Prepare college essays (UC, private, out-of-state colleges).
- Research scholarship opportunities.
- If necessary, obtain supplemental financial aid apps for the colleges you would like to attend.
- CSS/PROFILE available online (app for non-government financial aid at many private colleges and universities).
- Students interested in Military careers should sign up for the ASVAB test in the counseling office with Mrs. Seider.

NOVEMBER

- Submit college applications for UC and CSU (Deadline is November 30th).
- Check with each campus' housing services to determine if your housing application is due at the time you submit your general application for admission.
- Send transcripts to colleges if requested.
- Send test scores to colleges if you have not sent them already.
- Provide updated contact information (i.e. address, phone number, email address) to Mrs. Seider in the College & Career Center.
- Take the ASVAB test.

DECEMBER

- Make sure your official SAT and ACT scores were sent to the colleges you applied to.

- Submit remaining college applications if appropriate.

JANUARY

- Contact college admissions offices to be sure they've received all necessary application materials.
- Complete CSS/PROFILE if necessary and submit by priority deadline.
- Apply to other area community colleges.
- LOCAL SCHOLARSHIPS – See Mrs. Seider in the College & Career Center for more information.
- Check individual college web portals for important to do lists and English/math placement testing requirements (if applicable).

FEBRUARY

- Check the college portals of the schools you're applying to and make sure you have submitted all necessary information for financial aid. Ask the financial aid offices how you should proceed if you have made corrections on your SAR.
- Submit Local Scholarship applications to Mrs. Seider in the College & Career Center.
- Continue to check individual college web portals for important information from colleges re: housing, deposits, etc.
- Continue to work on and/or submit your FAFSA application.

MARCH-APRIL

- March 2nd is the deadline** to submit Cal Grant and FAFSA forms for students seeking a Cal Grant.
- Review, compare, and respond to acceptance offers.
- If placed on waitlist, contact school to reiterate interest.
- Continue community college application, assessment, and orientation/counseling processes.
- Register for Community College classes.

MAY

- Make decision of which school you will attend and send in necessary deposits (deadline is often May 1st).
- Complete housing documentation if applicable.
- Review and complete student loan documentation if applicable.
- Take AP exams if applicable and send scores to college you will be attending.
- Send thank-you letters to appropriate individuals (e.g., scholarship agencies, recommenders, teachers).

JUNE-AUGUST

- Contact registrar to have final transcripts sent to your college by June 4th.
- Send final transcripts to NCAA Eligibility Center.
- Contact college to determine when tuition and housing fees are due and how much they will be.
- Finalize housing plans.
- Participate in summer orientation/advising programs for new students.
