

Aquatic Safety Certification Training Details

Thank you for signing up for Aquatic Safety Certification training for the 2024-2025 school year. Below are details of the steps that you will need to take in order to complete your certification. Step 1: Aquatic Safety Content

Use the link below to create an account if you have not created a Red Cross account before or log in if you already have an account. You will pay \$25 for the class and do the online portion which could take 2.5 hours to complete. Once you have completed the online portion, please submit a digital copy of this certificate along with a reimbursement form on Informed K12. RJUHSD will reimburse you for this cost.

Note: You will need to show the Water Safety Training online certification to the training instructor on PD 1. This certificate of completion is required in order for you to participate in the in-water skills session on Aug. 5th.

Step 2: Water Safety Training (In Water)

You are currently scheduled to attend the following in-person water training course and a Google calendar invite has been sent to you: **PLEASE email Rob Hasty to confirm your attendance for the August 5th in water session.**

Please arrive on time and show the Water Safety certificate proving your completion of the online portion of the course before the in-water skills session. **Note: You must complete the online portion of the course before participating in the in-water portion of the training. Those who fail to complete the online portion of the course and provide proof of completion will be refused in-water training on the scheduled date.**

Step 3: CPR/AED/FA Training

* It will ask you to create a LOGIN if you already do not have an account at the Red Cross.

- Complete the course - The estimated time of completion is two and a half hours.
- Screenshot the *Congratulations* page.

*** After completion of the online portion, participants should complete the In-person session within 60 days.**

2. Register for an [in-person skills session](#). Please select a date, complete and submit the form.

If the date you chose is FULL, please choose another date. You might want to have your name on a waiting list. In this case please send an email with your request including your name, phone number, and desired date. If a spot becomes available you will receive an email/phone call requesting to register for the class.

Note: After registering, if you need to cancel please send an email at least 24 hours prior to the class date. Failure to do so might require you to pursue CPR [certification outside](#) the district at your own expense. To cancel please send an email to pwydenes@rjuhsd.us
