- 1 Int Math scores performed higher than District scores. Female scores were higher than male scores. Hispanic students taking AP tests with scores were consistent.
- ii Challenges:
 - 1 Lower scores for Hispanic and African American scores. Low number of African American students taking an AP test (especially considering the enrollment). Loss of funding has decreased number of students taking AP tests. Achievement gaps still exist.
