- IV. Purpose of Site Council Review
 - Guzman: First purpose is to set a school achievement plan. Explained the CSI process. Explained the perception and demographic data, the finding of common themes, and implications of strengths/challenges to set goals and resources through the lense of school goals. A more systematic process throughout the District and site with school site council. Second purpose is cultivating school community (relationships).
- V. CSI (Demographic Review (Highlights))
 - Review Perception Data together/Identify Strengths/Challenges/Implications
 - Themes of school (Strengths): Diversity, strong AP, decrease in discipline referrals, 97% attendance rate, 99% graduation rate. (Challenges): High F/R numbers, lower attendance in SPED, lack of staff diversity, drop in males per 4 year cohort, linguistic challenges (EL).
 - Passed out Perception data from Parent Questionnaire Results. Guzman: What are some of the strengths, challenges or implications?
 - Perception data from Parent Questionnaire Results (386 responses)
 - Strengths:
 - Parents mention that they feel safe.

- Parents and students understand the expectations of the schools.
- Parents and students feel Antelope is welcoming.

Challenges:

- Common issues with fights on campus.
- Students are not treated fairly by other students, but improve as they get older.

Implications:

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- Perception data from Student Questionnaire Results (1507 responses)

Strengths:

- Teachers have clear expectations.
- Students like the Antelope..
- Equal balance of responses from both male and female students.
- Students are liked and treated fairly by other students.

Challenges:

- Where do kids fit in? Guzman: Issues with identity, disconnect with face-to-face communication..

Implications:

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Questions about survey: How do we distinguish ethnic groups (i.e. Indian and Slavic families? Where do they fit in under demographics by total respondents?

Guzman: At next meeting we will review and discuss some implications and systems we could put in place?
