TUESDAY, MAY 28, 2024

Community members will have an opportunity to comment on how school dollars are being spent at public hearings on the District's Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP) and preliminary Budget. **The meeting will be held Tuesday, May 28, 2024, at 6:30 p.m. at the District Office, 1750 Cirby Way, Roseville** (see rjuhsd.us website @ School Board/Board Meeting Agendas for details and to confirm the meeting location).

The purpose of this meeting is to provide information to the public and to receive public comment and input on the spending plans for the upcoming year. The public will also have the opportunity to submit written comments regarding the District's LCAP. A form will be available for this purpose or a letter may be submitted during the meeting as well. The Superintendent or designee will respond in writing to all written comments received at the meeting.

The LCAP is a district's plan to meet annual goals for all pupils, with specific activities to address State and local priorities. More information regarding the LCAP is available at the district's website www.rjuhsd.us/lcap.

The Budget and LCAP are scheduled to be presented to the Board for adoption at the June 11, 2024 Board meeting.
