IM 2 Course Grading Policy:

1. *Course Work (homework, group work, tasks)* (5%)

Exams are the student's opportunity to show what they have learned and know. Summative unit exams will contain segments from the chapters it covers. Retakes are NOT allowed for summative assessments.
