- What is the purpose?
 - Title I funding can be spent on ALL students
 - Continuation school automatically qualifies for Title I funds
 - What is LEA?
 - Local Education Agencies
 - What is ConAp?
 - Consolidated Applications, state and federal funding
 - Designed to support:
 - EL students
 - Low socioeconomic students
 - Foster and homeless youth
 - Funding sources come from Title I and Title III (ELD), LCAP (state funding, serving the underserved community)
 - Site Council
 - 1 student
 - 2 parents/ community members
 - 3 staff members
 - For schools less than 300 students more compliant components:
 - Create and have students, parents, and community members vote on the ballot
 - Not enough participants, Principal must show due diligence that every attempt was made to nominate site council representatives.
