The final test is held the last day of the session at Granite Bay HS. Students will receive the pink slip required by the DMV immediately after passing the final test.

***NOTE:** The times listed above are the start times for the test. The student must arrive to take the test between 2:45 and 3:30. Do **not** arrive later than 3:30. The student has as much time as needed to complete the test. Please arrive with a pencil or pen with which to take the test.
