- Login - Link on RHS Website
- Students – First name and student ID (Student login more detailed)
- Parents – need student ID number PPstudentID3
- Search in different career clusters based on questions in Naviance. CollegeBoard.Org also provides an assessment.
- Top 3 careers selected – students can look for classes/knowledge areas in High School. Explore what education is needed and wages. Students can also explore colleges based on results.
- Junior Year – college search. Individual meeting with Counselor.
- Link the careers interests with colleges with majors – help to look at what majors are available. Can view average Test Scores/GPAs, and tuition for each college. Scholarship information.
- Naviance – Career center maintains a list of local scholarships.
