I. PRIOR BUSINESS – KAREN COOPER:

- a. November 2013 meeting minutes were reviewed and approved with the following change: added \$1,228.12 as balance carried over from last year.
- b. Karen Cooper moves to sponsor \$720 for two teachers (math/English) for the fall SAT prep class, open to juniors and seniors. Aileen Zarea Seconded. Motion was passed.
- c. Lindsey Parker would like to keep discussions open to sponsor T-shirt for freshman class. Can be tabled for April/May 2014 based on fundraising efforts.

III. PROGRAMS TO SPONSOR - MATT PIPITONE:

- a. ACT Aspire test would have to be taken online.
- b. Platforms not compatible with what we have. Will check on compatibility with Chrome, tablet, etc.
- c. It was suggested we hold off on sophomore sponsorship until the school can do further research.

IV. FUNDRAISING - KAREN COOPER/MARIE ORTEGA:

- a. Big fundraising push at back to school night.
- b. Trying to implement Square or Paypal for website/onsite payments.
- c. Will advertise through school bulletin, website, facebook, and marquee.
- d. All parents can help raise funds via team moms, boosters club, etc.
- e. Will post campaign letter on website.
- f. Contributors will be recognized via website, facebook, school newspaper and possibly Freshman T-Shirts.
- g. One parent suggested a fundraiser with a father/son (or daughter) basketball game. Freshman vs. Juniors? Will follow-up with some of the coaches to see if they can support this effort.
 - o Can sell tickets, food and drinks. As well as get cheerleaders, and volunteers who need service hours.
- h. "Pennies for Change" was also discussed. Kids would collect change and place it containers in cafeteria.
 - o ½ proceeds go to wining class, the other ½ would go to parents club.

V. TRESUREE'S REPORT - BY LORI CARMENA:

- a. Current Balance is \$2,617.20. Includes \$220 collected from membership dues, and a \$300 donation.
- b. Debbie Mulligan moves to approve the 2013-2014 proposed budget. Heidi Keaton seconded. Motioned was passed with the following change: Added a \$200 annual scholarship and \$720 for Fall SAT Prep class.

VI. OTHER BUSINESS:

 - o \$200 scholarship, academic growth for kids, recommended to review goals/objectives on website.
- b. Asked for volunteers for Tiger Pride awards on December 17th. 3 parents volunteered to read awards in classrooms.
