V. Presentation, District Local Control Accountability Plan, Mr. Byrd.

Mr. Byrd presented an overview of the LCAP and ideas.

It is part of local control funding formula, new model in last 3 years to provide additional funding and support for the most at risk students. Got rid of all the different funds, with strings and instead put in 1 pot for each district and have each district make decisions on how to use it. Going into 3rd year to do this. District values input for people from parents, students, teachers about how spending the money and new fresh ideas. Parents get a chance to contribute. Do 1 of these meetings at every school, suggestions is at PC. SES: social economic students (poor) low income. EL English learners. RHS 72% Parallel numbers for district.

Spent on EL, college readiness for all students.

RHS has historically provided EL teachers and has had a program. Designated 28 since last April. About 25%. Kids are more empowered, more engaged. EL kids will take this EL class, is an elective they have to use.

CAHSEE Calif HS exit exam, no longer required.
