6. SAT Prep course -- Mr. Bradley

- A. Academic Initiative = Vision of Parent Club
 - a. Fund SAT Prep Classes – historically no classes
 - b. Parent Club and RHS fund classes

FALL SESSION - SAT PREP Classes - 7 Classes

- Start 10/10 – 11/3, 3-5 pm
- (October 10, 11, 17, 20, 24, 27 Nov 3)
- Cost is \$20 for Parent Club Members
- Parent Club members get 2 days before to register
- Fletcher (Math) and Wise (English) teaching class – based on new SAT
- Sports practices – cannot work around practices
- Recommended that Juniors take SAT and ACT in Spring and then again in Fall
- 9/21&22 - WED/THURS - Sign up for Parent Club members
- 9/23 – General Registration

B. Mr. Bradley attended CSU Conference

- CSU increased SAT numbers for admissions
- Students are scoring higher in new SAT

Question from member: Is there data on the past SAT training?

- Mr. Bradley – Not yet. Will do it this year. (Will have students self-report.)
- Mr. Mattix – When he gave classes he saw points go up about 200 points

How is new SAT score compared to old SAT?

- Mr. Bradley - College Boards has info on this.

Is Mr. Bradley the coordinator?

- Mr. Bradley - No, we have several other teachers in charge

7. Mr. Byrd, Principal - What's ahead this year for RHS? Fall Topics

Roar Support Period

Western Assoc. of Schools and Colleges reviews every 6 years and gives a rating

RHS received highest rating – with recommendations:

1. Assess Professional Development for Staff
2. Systemic intervention during the day (i.e ROAR Period)
 - a. Presented data of grades (important for A-G requirements – UC/CSU)
 - i. 45% A | 25% B | 16.5% C | 5.7% D | 6.7% F
- ROAR period to provide extra support for students. Also to intervene with students that are failing. Used to make up tests.

- Common Learning Centers for use during ROAR period: Library, Cafeteria & Patti Baker Theater
- Results?
 - Progress Report Compared to last year -Increase in A's and decrease in D's and F's
- Oakmont and Antelope have been models for ROAR Support Period
- Questions:
 - Q: Why morning for ROAR? -- A: Earlier in the day – stats say more students are engaged and teachers available
 - Q: Does ROAR count toward instructional minutes? -- A: Yes
 - Q: Priority Period – Can teachers keep them in priority period if they have another appt? -- A: No they should not
- Considering opening up College and Career Center for ROAR period

MEASURE D

- October meeting - District will come to speak along with Mr. Byrd
- Slide Show - Presentation of pictures of areas that need improvement
- Designed to raise \$96 million dollars
- 1/3 to go to new high school
- Avg \$13 million per school – access to monies for the next 2 decades
- 10/20 – Parents Club night for phone banking
 - 20 minute Training at phone bank
 - Don't have to be there the whole time
- Citizens Oversight committee – to oversee how money will be sent.
- District has started collecting potential projects
