Site Council Minutes

November 7th, 2018

1. **Call to Order** – 5pm
2. **Approval of Minutes** – Meeting minutes were unanimously approved.
3. **Opportunity for Public Input** – Mrs. Gaigan asked questions related to the previous meetings Special Education Presentation. A. Do students need to go through the Intervention Pyramid prior to receiving service? Staff explained that students/parents always have the legal right to request assessment for Special Education Services. Once the request is made (No matter where the student is in relation to the Pyramid) the LEA is required to begin the assessment process. B. In relation the Least Restrictive Environment, do we really need to worry about stigmatization? Staff explained that Stigmatization is something that we discuss with families, as families often have varied opinions and beliefs about Special Education Services. Some parents want their student involved in Special Education while others don't.
4. **Student Updates** – Students reported that the rally was cancelled due to rumors on social media that there was going to be a shooting on campus (unfounded and was fully investigated). Additionally, students reported that the yearly Culture Fest event was scheduled for that night at 7pm. Student Government is working on both Breaking Down the Walls and Santa's helpers.

 - c. **MTSS (Multi-Tiered Systems of Intervention)** – Mr. Hasty, reviewed what MTSS (Multi-Tiered System of Support) is and how we are using these strategies on campus to support students, teachers, parents, and the OHS community. Additionally, site administrators will be training all staff on MTSS as well as answering any questions they may have.
