1. Bylaws Review and Action presented by Isabel Govea -

  - b. Govea: district came together to draft bylaws to ensure consistency for all sites, best practice to review site laws once a year or so. We can change a little, but goal is for OHS to not deviate too much to maintain consistency. May need to add something about how to handle public feedback from Google Form. Notable change - student is on a one-year term and must be elected in a schoolwide election at the beginning of the fall term. Other notable change - public comment limited to 1

minute. Possible change to add - if we have more teacher volunteers than openings, we will run elections, and if we don't have enough volunteers, we will not run elections. This applies to parent position as well. Must name chairperson/vice-chairperson, secretary - T. Montgomery Chairperson, L. Perkins Vice-Chairperson, K. Sunseri Secretary, I. Govea principal. Notable change - Google Form public comment form. We will add: "Any public comment submitted in writing, delivered electronically, or otherwise not delivered in person will be made available to Site Council members for their review prior to the meeting." Goal of public comment is to inform members about agenda items, not make a new action item or be unrelated to Site Council business. SSC is not a school board meeting, just approving supplemental materials and not entirely new curriculum.
